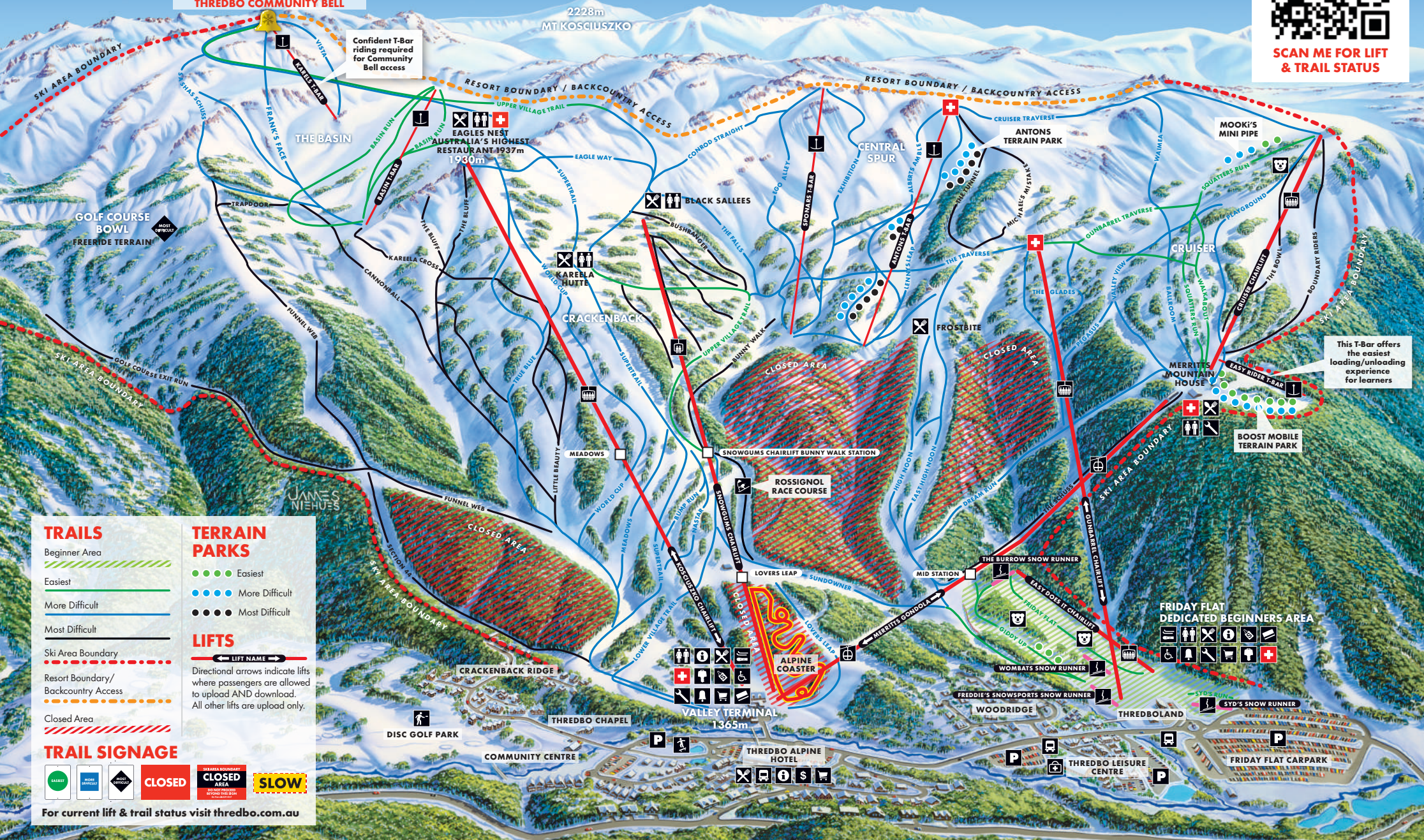

SAFETY TIPS
Stay in control & own your ride!
Make sure you can stop, turn, and avoid surprises on the slopes.

Know your zone!
The riders ahead and below you have the right of way - it's your job to steer clear.

Pick your pit stop wisely!
Only stop where others can see you from above, and don't block the flow.

Check before you shred!
Always look uphill before dropping in or merging onto a trail.

Respect the signs, stay inbounds!
Obey all warnings, markings, and closures - adventure smart, not reckless!

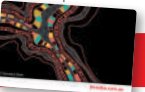

RISK WARNING

- Recreational activities (including skiing, snow grooming, using lifts, alpine coaster, mountain biking and to a lesser degree hiking) involve a significant risk of physical harm or personal injury including permanent disability and/or death to participants. Any such injury may result not only from your actions but from the action, omission or negligence of others.
- You must observe the Alpine Responsibility Code and conduct yourself in a safe, responsible and controlled manner at all times.
- By using your lift pass or accessing the Resort you acknowledge that you have read and understood, and agree to be bound by, the Terms and Conditions of Use. Helmets - Thredbo strongly recommends all skiers and snowboarders wear helmets. Helmets are an important safety consideration and may prevent or reduce head injuries. Helmets are mandatory for all Thredbo Snowsports lesson participants and for all guests using Thredbo terrain parks, regardless of lesson participation. Helmets are available to rent or buy from Retail and Rental locations in resort.

Trail Signage - You'll find the trail signs shown in the trail map key at various places on the mountain, they are there for your safety and protection. Please take note of them and obey them, particularly the "Ski Area Boundary" and "Closed Area" signs.

Tobogganing - Tobogganing, snowtubing and general snowplay are not permitted in Thredbo.

YOUR ALPINE RESPONSIBILITY CODE

Winter sports involve risk of serious injury or death. Your knowledge, decisions and actions contribute to your safety and the safety of others.

KNOW YOUR ABILITY

- Stay in control. You must be able to stop or avoid people or objects.
- You must know how and be able to load, ride and unload lifts safely. If you need assistance, ask the lift attendant.
- Do not ski, board, ride lifts or use terrain, if your ability is impaired by drugs or alcohol.

KNOW YOUR ROLE

- Use protective equipment (especially helmets) to minimise the risk of injury. Prevent runaway equipment.
- Read and obey all signs, warnings and hazard markings.
- Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
- If you are involved in a collision or incident, do not leave the scene. Share your contact information with each other and Resort Staff.

KNOW YOUR ZONE

- People ahead and downhill of you have right of way. You must avoid them.
- Stop only where you are visible from above and do not restrict traffic.
- Before starting downhill, or merging into a trail, look uphill and give way to others.
