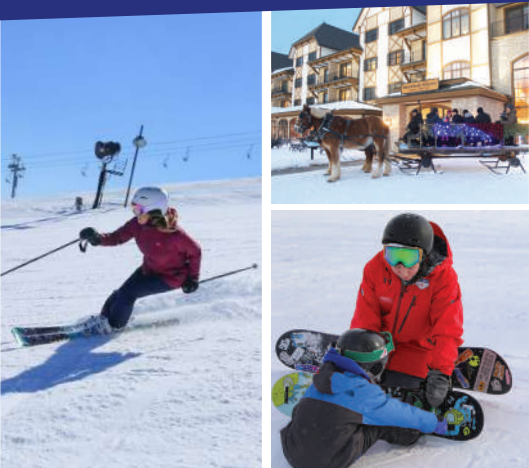

SKIER & SNOWBOARDER RESPONSIBILITY CODE & SAFETY TIPS

Skiing, snowboarding, and tubing can be enjoyed in many ways. At ski areas you may see people (some handicapped) using alpine, snowboard, telemark, cross country, or other specialized ski equipment. Regardless of how you decide to enjoy the slopes, always show courtesy to others and be aware that there are elements of risk in skiing that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce. Observe the code listed below and share with other skiers the responsibility for a great experience.

1. Always stay in control and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
2. People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3. You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
4. Whenever starting downhill or merging onto a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
5. Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
6. Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
7. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.

IN CASE OF AN ACCIDENT

1. Place skis (crossed) or snowboard upright in the snow above the scene of the accident.
 2. Report the accident to any Boyne Mountain employee or any lift station.
 3. For quickest assistance, please remain calm and give an accurate location and nature of the injury.
 4. In the event of a collision with another skier or rider, please stop to determine if any injury occurred and if so, remain with the injured person(s) at the accident site until Ski Patrol arrives. Failure to do so could result in substantial fine and/or arrest.
